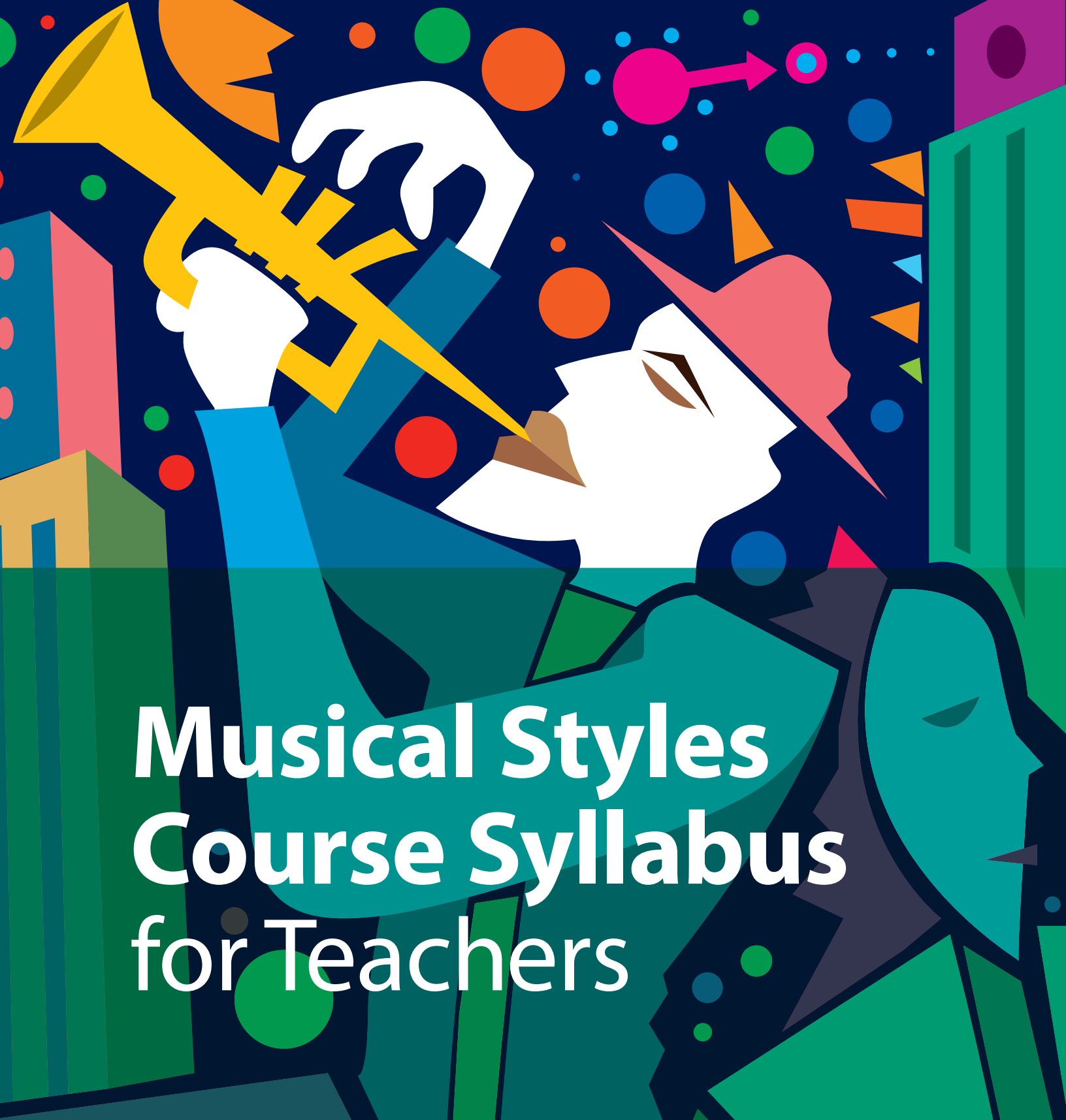




Musical Styles Course Syllabus for Teachers
